Town of Warner OHRV Policy


1. This policy is in accordance with RSA 215-A and RSA 215-C, which authorizes municipal select boards to regulate the operation OHRVs and snowmobiles within the town borders through either bylaws or a select board ordinance.
2. This policy will be reviewed annually.
3. The NH definition of OHRVs per RSA 215-A:1-b includes the following:
 - a. ATVs
 - b. Dirt bikes
 - c. snowmobiles
 - d. Legally registered motor vehicles, when used for off highway recreational purposes
4. OHRVs used by or under direction of the Warner Police Department, Warner Fire Department, Warner Emergency Management, the Warner American Legion Post, and NH Fish & Game are allowed on all Class V and VI roads in Warner, as needed to perform their jobs.
5. All other OHRVs are not allowed to travel on Class V and Class VI roads in Warner, except as covered below.
6. Snowmobiles are permitted on snow covered Class VI, seasonal Class V roads and elsewhere, as permitted under RSA 215-C.
7. ATVs are permitted to use certain Class VI roads in Warner, per agreement between the Warner Select Board and the Bound Tree ATV Club. This agreement will be reviewed for renewal as part of the annual review of this policy.
8. No motorized wheeled vehicle of any type shall be allowed to operate on Class VI Roads within the Town of Warner for the sole purpose of "recreational riding", without any other intended purpose for being operated on these roads. "Recreational Riding" does not include using legally


registered wheeled vehicles on these roads for the purposes of hunting, fishing, hiking or other lawful purposes.


9. Where OHRV travel on Class VI roads is not permitted, signs will be posted to that effect per order of the Warner Board of Selectmen.
10. The Warner Police Department will track enforcement incidents related OHRV's. The Chief will review these statistics and enforcement plans with the Warner Select Board as part of the annual review of this policy.
11. The Warner Public Works Director will prepare a report on the condition of Class VI roads within Warner, highlighting any concerns as part of the annual review of this policy.
