



Fire Station Alternate Sites Committee Meeting Schedule

1. Wednesday, May 21, 2014

Identify /List Necessary Qualifications for the building site –

Priority level 1 – required for the site

Priority level 2 – necessary but not required

Set a definition of the “Ideal” building site for the new fire station

Discuss /List questions/concerns about location of fire station likely raised by neighbors and other residents and stakeholders

2. Wednesday, May 28, 2014

Tour of the present proposed building site and adjacent property (136 East Main St.)

List the assets and liabilities of this site – the site’s contribution to overall cost of construction with respect to meeting some of the qualifications required for a suitable building site

3. Wednesday, June 4, 2014

Review zoning maps of Warner Village – form teams and assign maps to teams to study for identifying suitable properties for a building site using qualifications from first meeting

* Progress report given to the Board of Selectmen at 6/10 Board meeting

4. Wednesday, June 11, 2014

Teams will present feasible sites-1st and 2nd choices. Sites are ranked by full committee based on qualifications of each site

5. Wednesday, June 18, 2014

Review ranking of sites to revise the ranking to identify the four most feasible sites

Brainstorm options and next steps to recommend to the Board of Selectmen

6. Wednesday, June 25, 2014 --- (Open meeting date for any follow-up or canceled meetings)
