- Develop FAQ's that we can use on web sites and in town newsletters: Neil & George
- Work with the CDFA to see how they can support the project: Clyde

Items that we will want to pursue during the course of the year

- Hold an abutter meeting
- Meet with the Conservation Commission to review the project
- Approach Sugar River Savings Bank about financing the project.
- Work with Eversource to maintain their approval for the project
- Determine if we need ZBA approval for the project and, if so, get it
- Hold additional public information / education sessions
- Make sure we have supporters identified and that they will make the town meeting.
