

Minutes of the Meeting of the  
Warner Village Water District Commissioners  
At 9:00 A.M. on  
April 1, 2019 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Peter Newman, Peter Savlen, and Dan Lavoie, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes**

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held on March 25, 2019 were not considered for approval.

**Administrator's Report**

Ray reported that the new Toyota Tacoma truck had been delivered. It came in at about \$2,000 under the dealer's price.

Ray advised of further discussions he has had with two Warner residents concerning their intention to open a small craft brewery in the Clough building on Depot Street. The District is worried about the type and amounts of chemicals used in brewing and cleaning the equipment to be used. The parties state that they are planning on a 3-barrel brew house, with a weekly output of 7 barrels, requiring 1,400 gallons of water for the beer production. They will have to treat the wash water to control the ph before sending the effluent to the treatment plant. Chuck will find out the list of chemicals to be used. An industrial discharge permit will likely be required.

The Commissioners discussed the planned meeting with the Board of Selectmen on the Town Hall water hook-up for fire suppression. This meeting is currently scheduled for Tuesday, April 9. Ray will continue to coordinate with Jim Bingham.

Also discussed was the effluent injection project. Ray asked Dan and other Commissioners to meet with him and the Conservation Commission on Wednesday to provide them brief them on the proposal.

Meeting adjourned at 10:00 AM.
