

Warner Agricultural Commission approved minutes from the February 12th, 2024 meeting.

- Members discussed the minutes from the January 8th, 2024 meeting. A motion was made to approve the minutes and it was unanimously approved.
- Members discussed the Agricultural Commission partnering with the Warner Historical Society to host an event in April of 2024. The April 6th 2024 date was confirmed for the event. The location will be Warner Town Hall. Rebecca Courser recommended the Agricultural Commission do a brief introduction of the Commission members and explain the mission of the Commission. Additionally, a brief discussion regarding the Farm Survey results, would provide feedback to the public. Advertising the event will be through local social media, and email distribution. Additionally, Rebecca Courser will be producing posters.
- Members discussed providing a response to the Warner Housing Advisory Committee's request to answer two questions they sent out to all town Committees and Commissions. Bob Bower reiterated the fact that housing shortfalls are a systemic national problem, not just a Warner problem. Members decided there's a need for more study and research before we can respond as a Commission. Bob Bowers and Bill Hanson agreed to reach out to the town of Boscawen's Agricultural Commission to see if they have sent any recommendations to their Housing Advisory Committee.
- Members discussed recruiting new members to fill vacancies on the Agricultural Commission. Mike Biagiotti agreed to send out a recruiting email to those who responded with interest to the Farm Survey.
