Selectboard Meeting DRAFT Minutes

January 26, 2024

Lower Meeting Room Warner Town Hall 5 E Main St

Open the Meeting and Roll Call

- Chair Seidel reconvened the meeting at 10:15 AM.
- Present: Harry Seidel (Chair), Faith Minton, Allan Brown
- Also Present: Georgia Flanders, Butch Burbank, Judy Newman-Rogers, Clyde Carson

Capital Budget/Warrant Articles

- Warrant Article Changes
 - Article 15: \$115,000 Revaluation Article
 - Use unassigned fund balance to fund revaluation rather than revenue
 - New Wording: Shall the town vote to raise and appropriate \$115,000 to be added to the previously established property revaluation capital reserve fund to be raised through the unassigned fund balance and not by taxation.
 - Faith Minton made the motion to revise the article, and Allan Brown seconded it.
 The motion passed unanimously.
 - Article 13: Article to be abandoned
 - Was to be written by David Carle in conjunction with Elizabeth Labbe and Avitar
 - Tension between assessing firm and resident desire for change in methods of solar assessing
 - Avitar assesses solar according to state RSAs and will not use David Carle's proposed formula
 - Concerns regarding previous solar article's legality according to DRA
 - Issue must be solved at the state level
 - Chair Seidel made the motion to eliminate the solar article. Faith Minton seconded the motion, and the motion passed unanimously.
- Petition Articles
 - Public hearing scheduled for January 30
 - Discussion order: Food Pantry, 5-member Select Board, Zoom recordings, Elected Planning Board, Elected ZBA, Town Clerk/Tax Collector

- Ballot Articles
 - Elected Planning Board
 - Are you in favor of electing the Warner Planning Board consisting of 7 members which includes one ex-officio member selected by the Select Board and the remaining planning board positions shall be filled on a staggered basis at the subsequent regular elections pursuant to RSA 669:17 as the term of an appointed member expires, until each member of the board is an elected member?
 - Recommended by Select Board 3-0
 - Elected Zoning Board
 - Are you in favor of electing the Warner Zoning Board consisting of 5 members to be filled on a staggered basis at the subsequent regular town elections pursuant to RSA 669:17 as the term of an appointed member expires?
 - Recommended by Select Board 3-0
 - Five-member select board
 - Petitioned article
 - Must be on the ballot due to calling for a change in town government
 - Will be voted on after public hearing
 - Combined town clerk and tax collector position
 - Further research to be conducted by select board before public hearing
 - Are you in favor of combining the offices of the Town Clerk and Tax Collector to create a new office of Town Clerk/Tax Collector with the term of office of three years? If approved, an article shall be placed on the ballot at the next annual meeting to choose a Town Clerk/Tax Collector. (Majority Ballot Vote Required)
 - Recommended by Select Board 3-0

Employment

- Building Permits and Zoning Compliance Position
 - Helps to reallocate duties and decreases pressure on upstairs offices
- Assessing
 - Current assessing clerk running for tax collector, and cannot perform both jobs legally
 - At this point, withdrawal is possible
 - Creates conflict due to training of staff on new assessing software
 - Budget for assessing clerk has been increased, but stipend of tax collector has decreased

Davis Road

- The board met on January 12 at 10:00 AM to discuss the condition of Davis Road.
- The issue is unresolved, as taxpayer funds cannot be spent on Class VI roads.
 - Possibility of reclassifying road as an emergency lane
 - Would require a public hearing
