

## Warner Agricultural Commission meeting notes from April 11, 2022

- Members discussed the grant proposal being drafted by member Biagiotti. Recommendations were made to add additional commission members to the grant application to include the project manager position. Additionally, it was recommended that PO Box 265 be added to the applicant address. This grant is through Northeast SARE, and will provide funding for the Agricultural Commission to conduct community outreach. A motion was made to forward the edited grant proposal, and that motion was unanimously approved.
- Member Amelia Gardner made a motion for the Agricultural Commission to support the effort underway to construct and operate a community garden, that motion was unanimously approved.
- Previously, the Warner Zoning Board had requested the Agricultural Commission to provide input on the topic of Agritourism. After discussion, a motion was made for the Agricultural Commission to provide the following response: The Warner Agricultural Commission supports current state regulations regarding Agritourism, and would like to be involved in any future planning and or zoning changes regarding agriculture in the town of Warner. That motion was unanimously approved.
