

Approved meeting minutes from the Agricultural Commission meeting on August 14th, 2023

- Members discussed and approved meeting minutes edited from the month of June. Additionally, member voted on and approved the meeting minutes from the month of July.
- Members discussed the response from the Warner Fall Foliage Festival vendor coordinator regarding vendor prioritization.
- Member Biagiotti gave an update on the farm survey. We have had 193 responses to this point, and we will continue to breakdown the feedback from residents.
- Members discussed the ultimate goal of the survey, and the importance of editing the questions and what we want to accomplish with the second farm survey.
- Guest speaker Craig Tufts from the Central New Hampshire Regional Planning Commission. Member Amaral, who is also a member of the Warner Conservation Commission invited Craig to our meeting. The Conservation Commission is working to have agricultural lands in the town of Warner identified through GIS mapping. Craig gave a detailed explanation of how Warner agricultural lands are identified and how soil quality is graded. This will be an ongoing process, and the information gathered from this endeavor will be valuable to the Agricultural Commission moving forward.
- Members discussed the agenda for the month of September.
- Members discussed moving forward with the plan for the Agricultural Commission having a presence in the WFFF parade. A group tractor ride is being organized, and there are several Warner residents interested in participating.
