



Warner Conservation Commission Meeting  
May 1, 2019

Meeting called to order at 7:22 pm.

- April's meeting notes need to be collated (multiple note-takers). Will be available at June's meeting.
- Town lots for sale – Lots # 5 and 9 are located close to Steven's Brook on North Road. Lot 5 may belong to the Chandler Reservation (needs verification). – Map 11, Lot 15 – Selectboard asked if the WCC would like to look at the lot. WCC voted not to take any action (e.g. site visit or further review).
- NHDOT I-89 Project – Nancy Martin will reach out to NHDES for the status of the list of potential mitigation sites submitted to DES last March. Will also ask timeline for submitting proposals to the ARM fund.
- Chandler Reservation trails assistance – Nancy Martin, Ken Cogswell and Chandler Res. Members and Forester walked the property to identify potential projects for the SCA/AmeriCorps volunteers to consider for 2020. There was interest by the SCA staff to assist in clearing and developing trails, including the interpretive trail. Would include some rerouting to get trail out of sensitive environmental areas. Up to 11 days of volunteer work would be available once a work plan was developed. Would need to provide some funding for housing & meals for the volunteers.
- HB 591 – ATV focused bill, would require notification of all abutters for new proposed ATV trail. HB 660 – Statewide study of the beneficial and adverse impacts of ATV recreation in a community, including social, environmental and economic impacts.
- A number of timber sales (3) have been posted in the Town Hall, but only one forestry notification was posted on the One-Stop NH website.
