2. Taking Action for Wildlife- Chilling Out at Chandler – about 30 people participated. Sledding, tree identification walk. Was a great success.
3. Mink Hills Recreation Study Committee Update- Creating a map of the Class VI roads, reviewing sections of roads from one junction to the next. Identifying what is needed for various recreational uses. Creating a grid that describes conditions that each recreational activity needs by season, will then overlay criteria over the roads. E.g. if sections of roads are generally flooded under normal rain events, would make specific recommendations for use.
4. Economic Development Advisory Committee – Meeting with tenants of the Old Grade School. Need to prioritize use of the building with existing uses and potential child care facility. There are grants that would support a child care center. See March 1, 2022 Warner Select Board minutes for additional information.

6. Forestry/Wetlands Permits- Ken Cogswell reported that missing land use staff are unavailable to provide the information regarding Forestry/Wetlands permits. Nothing is posted or on-line at this time.
