Warner Conservation Commission (WCC) members present: Susi von Oettingen, (voting in place of , Ken Cogswell, Phil Stockwell, Scott Warren, and Nancy Martin, Chair. Public: Barbara Marty Eversource representatives: Doug Pimentel- Specialist, Project Services, Dave Creer- Community Relations Specialist, Rick Sullivan- Eversource ROW Arborist.

The group gathered at the Eversource Relay Station on Pumpkin Hill Rd. at 2:00 pm. We walked through the prickly brush to the eastern bank of Willow Brook. We could see that the western stream bank of the brook had been clear cut all the way to the water. Eversource representatives and WCC members agreed that, along the western bank, there are signs of regrowth among the natural ground cover that remains following the brush cutting. About 20 yards up the hill, there was soil disturbance where no ground cover remains. Rick Sullivan said that Eversource would do some remediation with a landscape cover blanket seeded with native grasses and rye covered with hay to restore plant growth in the area where ground cover had been removed. Since signs of regrowth are already visible along the western bank, the bank would be left alone

The meeting was adjourned at 2:42 pm.
