I. 7:01 pm Open the Meeting/Roll Call

Chair Sam Bower opened the meeting at 6:30pm and called roll: Sam Bower, Christine Frost, Lois Shea, Diane Ricciardelli

II. Appointments

a. Request for Alcohol License – KVR Hospitality Corp.

New owners of “The Kitchen” restaurant, Patrick and Caroline Brodigan, would like to rename the restaurant “The Warner Tavern” and are requesting a new license to serve alcohol. The owners said they will be open five days a week to start and hope to be open seven days a week in the future. They will begin with lunch and dinner. They may look into doing brunch on the weekends. When asked, the owners commented that they are not planning to do any brewing of beer at this time. Perhaps this is something they’d like to do in the future.

Sam understood that there was an outdoor patio and porch. Would alcohol be served in these locations? The owner said that in the spring/summer/fall, they would make use of the outdoor seating area and would serve food and alcohol. Selectperson Lois Shea said the NH Liquor Commission would be in charge of setting parameters of where the alcohol could be served.

The interior of the restaurant will remain mostly the same for now, until they have been working in it for a while. They may expand the bar area in the back.

It was moved by Sam Bower and seconded by Selectperson Christine Frost to approve the sale of alcohol at the newly-established “Warner Tavern,” owned by Patrick and Caroline Brodigan (KVR Hospitality Corp.) as it was allowed at “The Kitchen” located at 15 S. Main Street in Warner. The motion was approved unanimously.

The meeting adjourned at 7:16pm.
