

Minutes of the Meeting of the  
Warner Village Water District Commissioners  
At 3:30 P.M. on  
May 10, 2023 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Shaun Murphy, Herm Blanchette and Dan Lavoie, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes**

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held April 26, 2023 were approved by the Commissioners.

**Administrator's Report**

Ray reported that the groundwater injection project is scheduled to begin with the installation of a temporary pipe, set across the Warner River, and located high enough to allow passage of canoes and other water craft. Ray indicated that he didn't yet have a firm date for the start of work.

He reported that the quarterly bills have been sent out and payments being received. Ray said that the 3 percent increase in rents should yield about \$3,000 over this year.

Chuck and Taylor are flushing hydrants this week.

Ray said that a leak in one of Market Basket's manholes has been detected and measures are being taken to address this issue.

Finally, Ray described their investigation of a manhole near the walking trail behind 70 East Main Street that had not previously been identified as part of the sewer system. When Chuck uncovered the manhole lid, he could see two pipes that were discharging significant quantities of water into the system. This appeared to be storm drainage and not sewage influent. Obviously if this is in fact storm water, it is imperative that the District determine the source, and take steps to stop it from entering the system. Ray said a dye test on sewage leaving houses upstream of this location will be undertaken.

The meeting adjourned at 3:55 P.M.
