

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Warner Village Water District Commissioners
At 3:30 P.M. on
June 28, 2023 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Shaun Murphy, and Dan Lavoie, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held June 14, 2023 were approved by the Commissioners.

Administrator's Report

Ray reported that several days ago following John Warzocha's call to Tracy Wood at DES about the delays in a temporary permit for the groundwater injection project, this permit was issued within a matter of hours. This has allowed work on the injection of treated effluent on the site across the river to be started. Ray said that Warzocha will be here tomorrow to dig pits and install the piping, with an expectation that the injection test process will begin within a week.

Ray reported that he has filed for and received the first payment of \$21,000 from NHDES for work already carried out on the project.

Ray also reported that the consulting firm, DPC, tasked with preparing a plan for proposed upgrades to the treatment plant to make the process more automated is close to being completed.

He said that the District has been awarded a \$50,000 grant to pay for a study of the sources of copper in the influent received at the plant. It was observed that the whole point of initiating the injection project was to avoid EPA's NPDES permit requirements, thus making the issue of copper sources irrelevant. Ray said that this point makes sense and that the District isn't obligated to conduct such a study.

The Commissioners approved sending the New Hampshire Guild of Woodworkers a check for \$50 to honor the memory of Peter Savlen who was a member of that organization.

The meeting adjourned at 4:10 P.M.
