

Minutes of the Meeting of the  
Warner Village Water District Commissioners  
At 3:30 P.M. on  
July 12, 2023 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Shaun Murphy, and Herm Blanchette, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

**Approval of Meeting Minutes**

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held June 28, 2023 were approved by the Commissioners.

**Administrator's Report**

Ray reported that Horizon Engineering has completed digging of five of the ribs as part of the groundwater injection project. A sixth rib will be done soon. They still have not accomplished setting the line across the river that will hold the piping. Ray noted that the Warner River is bank full as a result of the recent rain event. The Commissioners discussed the process of getting a line across the river. All of the necessary pump and metering equipment have been received.

Ray advised that the rains of the past few days and stormwater infiltration into the District's collection system has boosted influent to about 70,000 GPD. He will talk to Chuck about severing the drainage pipes carrying water into the manhole along the foot path.

Ray said that the treatment plant upgrade design plan from DPC Engineering should be delivered next week or the one after.

Ray reported that McDonalds Restaurant is still experiencing problems maintaining their grease trap, causing them internal plumbing back-ups. So far this has not affected the pump station.

The meeting adjourned at 4:00 P.M.
