

Minutes of the Meeting of the
Warner Village Water District Commissioners
At 4:15 P.M. on
July 26, 2023 at the Treatment Plant

Present: Shaun Murphy, and Herm Blanchette, Commissioners; Ray Martin, Administrator; and Jim McLaughlin, Clerk.

Approval of Meeting Minutes

The minutes of the Commissioners' regular meeting held July 26, 2023 were approved by the Commissioners.

Administrator's Report

Ray reported that he has received \$92,000 of Precinct Tax for the first half of 2023.

Concerning the groundwater injection project, Ray said that actual pumping of treatment plant effluent into the several ribs across the river will begin tomorrow. Horizon Engineering will be collecting data from the monitoring wells around the periphery. Test pumping will continue through October. John Warzocha has talked to NHDES about the length of time involved in this test and if it will be sufficient and has been assured that this shouldn't be a problem. Monitoring will concentrate on nitrate concentrations in the receiving groundwater.

On the manhole problem along the river, Ray said that Chuck plans to excavate the area around the manhole to uncover the pipes that are discharging storm drainage into the sanitary sewer and cut these pipes off. This should have a significant impact on flows into the plant. Ray plans to write a letter to homeowners along Main Street to alert them of this situation and deliver it in person. He will ask if any of these houses have drains that may be the source of the water, and alert anyone who may be unaware that their property is the source. In this latter case, stopping the flow could have an adverse impact on that house.

Ray reported that Primex has advised the District that they will offer Rob Knight a lump sum payout of \$19,000 which will close out any further involvement concerning him.

The meeting adjourned at 4:55 P.M.
