As part of our everyday effort to deliver reliable energy to our customers and communities, we will be performing environmental assessments, wetlands delineations, and data collection within the existing power line corridor in Warner, N.H.

These wetland delineations and data collection efforts provide us with valuable information about the field conditions in preparation for upcoming improvements to the power line.

What You Can Expect

First, we want you to know that this field work will not interrupt electric service to your property, and that crews always carry proper identification.

Over the next two to three weeks, our contractor, Vanasse Hangen Brustlin, Inc. (VHB), will be in the power line corridor performing wetlands delineations and data collection. VHB personnel will carry a letter indicating that they are working on behalf of Eversource. All Eversource representatives are happy to show you their company identification.

Field crews will work during daylight hours, typically Monday through Friday, 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. If additional work hours are needed, we will request permission from municipal officials. Please keep in mind that the schedule may change due to weather or other unexpected circumstances. This field work is expected to be completed by the end of September 2020.
